Those claiming that the pro-Russian insurgents are attacking a corrupt, ultranationalist administration are unseemly. However, Ukrainian inhabitants should recognize that the Ukrainian administration is the smallest of two troubles; the revolutionaries have enacted far more awful atrocities than the administration. The insurrectionaries are also opposing any programs that would enrich the entire Ukraine and European continent (McKee, & Murphy, 2022). Russia may eventually triumph militarily, but it does not imply it will prevail in this conflict. An uprising in Ukraine might take root. Russia's political, domestic, and diplomatic consequences may jeopardize Putin's government. Sanctions imposed by the West are choking Russia's economy and may have long-

term consequences (Harris, 2020). In the short term, Russia's conflict has reinforced the Western alliance, but that democratic will may be tested as oil prices rise and the conflict and refugee crisis continue.

There are significant distinctions between international relations and politics. One is a vast field responsible for establishing relationships between nations, while the other focuses on internal interactions inside a state. The exercise of power determines whether a nation is anarchic or sovereign. After the meeting, to prove his superiority over Ukraine, Putin launched a full-scale sea, air and land invasion, hitting Ukrainian resources such as military equipment and various towns across the republic. Biden while addressing the nation on the states of the conflict, called the strike "unprovoked and unjustifiable," and thereby imposing several restrictions on Russia to limit its partnership with the US and other regions in an attempt to end the war. this included restrictions on collaboration in trade especially in the gas and oil sector, and US software exports to the country. In a unique session called by the leaders of the UN, almost two-thirds of member nations were against the invasion by Russia claiming that it was not justified enough in comparison to the damage it caused to Ukraine (Lander, & Kuns, 2022). This indicates that despite the persistence of Russia in attacking Ukraine, most countries and organizations are fighting to uphold international

relations as they are essential in ensuring coexistence and peace globally. Therefore, the actions taken by the international community to protect those fleeing from Ukraine should be upheld, as every individual globally deserves peace.
